The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

1 In the absence of adequate evidence to demonstrate the need for new squash



facilities, the proposed loss of designated private open space would be contrary to policy CS15 (Protecting and improving our parks and open spaces and encouraging biodiversity) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy 31 (Provision of and improvements to, open space and outdoor sports and recreational facilities) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

The proposed development, by virtue of its combination of height, bulk, mass and design would have an adverse impact on the private open space and the character and appearance of the local area contrary to CS14 (Promoting High Quality Places and Conserving our Heritage) and CS15 (Protecting and improving our parks and open spaces and encouraging biodiversity) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 (Securing High Quality Design) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
