CPH UPPER - THE PROPOSED FACADE

The design of the facade is still developing as we uncover new pieces of archive evidence and refine the design with the help of the 20th Century Society. This process will continue after the planning stage and we hope to keep consulting the 20th Century Society and leaseholders.

We propose to restore the original 1960's qualities, by simplifying the glazing and cladding system such that frames are minimised and the facade appears flush which has been shown was Seifert's design intent. The new facade will match the original glazing rhythm.

To ensure the long-term future of the building, with viable running costs and reduced environmental impact, it is proposed that the existing fenestration is sensitively replaced, in the same format, using current technology. A modern double glazed curtain walling system which will bring the thermal and acoustic performance up to a current standards.

The glazing to the two stair towers will be upgraded with curtain glazing to match the existing profiles and fenestration pattern.

The mosaic tile cladding to the North and South gable walls and the balconies will be repaired and replaced where required.


The non-original elements on the balconies will be replaced with new sliding glass doors and new balustrades. The new balustrades will be glass topped with a flush timber element. This is a nod to the original balustrade designs which can not be replicated because they do not comply with modern saftey regulations.

The timber elements, possibly sapele, appear as strong and distinctive element within the original images. We propose that this original design element is reintroduced.

3D visualisations date from Jan 2013 and as such are out of date with the latest proposals that have evolved from consultation with 20th Century Society since January.









PERSPECTIVE SECTION STUDY - EXISTING CENTRE POINT HOUSE FACADE






PROPOSED - WEST ELEVATION (PART)
