ventilation for fumes and attenuation of noise would harm the amenity of neighbouring residents contrary to policies CS5 Managing the impact of growth and development, DP26 Managing the impact of development on occupiers and neighbours and DP28 Noise and Vibration of the London Borough of Camden LDF (Adopted 2010).
