Proposal:

Erection of single storey rear extension at ground floor level with two projecting rooflights, insertion of two windows to side elevation and new access door to rear garden from Courthorpe Road, in connection with ground floor flat (Class C3).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason:

Reason for Refusal

The proposed rear extension, by reason of its bulk, height and detailed design (including the projecting rooflights) would result in a dominant, visually intrusive addition which would fail to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of



the host building, and this part of the Mansfield Conservation Area. It would therefore be contrary to policy CS14 (promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
