2 All new work and work of making good shall be carried out to match the original work as closely as possible in materials and detailed execution.

3 The works hereby approved are only those specifically indicated on the drawing(s) referred to above.

 - a) Details and method of joining the structure to the building to include connections, fixing and means of sealing including flashings.
 - b) Details of surface finish and colour of the metalwork.
 - c) Plan, elevation and section drawings, of alterations to party wall at a scale of 1:20.

The relevant part of the works shall not be carried out otherwise than in accordance with the details thus approved.
