The Council has considered your application dated 16 January 2013 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The tree is considered to provide a decent level of visual amenity within the streetscape and to make a positive contribution to the character of this part of the conservation area. The tree appears to be in reasonable health with a significant safe, useful, life expectancy. Although the arboricultural report identifies some defects within the tree, these are not considered of sufficient significance to justify its removal.

The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and to preserve the character of this part of the conservation area.




Informative(s):

- 1 Please note the replacement of the other Cherry which was granted removal under application 2011/6346/T should be planted by the end of March 2013. The replacement should be either a *Prunus*, *Malus* or *Sorbus* with a girth size of 12-14cms. Failure to do so may result in a Tree Replacement Notice being served.
