The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The infill extension, by reason of its height and close proximity to No. 9 Sumatra Road, would have an adverse impact upon the residential amenity of the occupiers of No. 9 Sumatra Road, particularly the ground floor rear elevation and closet wing windows, in terms of daylight, outlook and sense of enclosure contrary to policy CS5 (Managing the impact of growth and development) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and to policy DP26 (Managing the impact of development on occupiers and neighbours) of the London



Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Plan.
