NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 11 OF APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMISSION

(To be published in a newspaper or to be served on an owner* or a tenant)**

Proposed development at (a) Duke's Road, south of the junction with Euston Road, London, WC1H, as shown in the location on the enclosed plan

I give notice that (b) Transport for London, 4th Floor, Palestra, 197 Blackfriars Road, London, SE1 8NJ

Is applying to the (c) London Borough of Camden

For planning permission to (d) Installation on the carriageway of a Barclays Cycle Hire docking station, containing a maximum of 29 docking points for scheme cycles plus a terminal.

* "owner" means a person having a freehold interest or a leasehold interest the unexpired term of which is not less than seven years, or, in the case of development consisting of the winning or working of minerals, a person entitled to an interest in a mineral in the land (other than oil, gas, coal, gold or silver).

** "tenant" means a tenant of an agricultural holding any part of which is comprised in the land.

Statement of owners' rights
