The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed double glazed window, by reason of the loss of existing historic glass and the historically inaccurate and inappropriate detail and finished appearance of the proposed glazing, would not preserve the special architectural and historic interest of the Grade II listed building nor the wider terrace of which it forms a part. This is contrary to the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, with particular regard to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage), and the London Borough of Camden Local



Development Framework Development Policies, with particular regard to policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage).
