

## **Green Roof**

The proposed green roof is an extensive sedum roof, which requires little or no maintenance due to the shallow layer of substrate suitable for low growing stress-tolerant grasses, mosses and alpine. Proposed species for use in this Sedum roof are Biting stonecrop (sedum acre), English stonecrop (sedum anglicum) and Orpine (sedum telephium).

An annual maintenance contractor will need to be appointed for the removal of any unwanted weeds and saplings.

There is to be a varying depth of substrate with a minimum depth of 80mm, this will allow for biodiversity and encourage wildlife to the roof. The varying depth of substrate enables a variety of grasses and wild plants to be introduced into the planting.
