I have contacted Tom Before but not yourself.

We looked at a medium lime tree in Agar Grove. Agar Grove is in a conservation area.

The base of the tree is in a bad state. It is covered in ivy therefore the damage had not been visible.

There is a huge round cavity in between two stems, there is a big crack in the base of the tree and i also found fruiting bodies (fungi, similar to those of Armillaria mellea (young honey fungus)). file:///h|/desktop/New%20Folder/11.txt

The tree falls under (DDD) Dead,Dying and Dangerous category. The tree has got to be dealt with before it gets worse and causes any damage to private property (cars) and also pedestrians passing on the private road right beneath the tree.
