REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

Proposal:

(TPO Ref: 12H) FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Horse Chestnut - Remove Easterly limb over road back to main stem.

The Council has considered your application dated 08 November 2012 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

This Horse Chestnut is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity within the public realm and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area. The proposed works would leave a large wound on the main stem which would take a considerable time to occlude and would leave the tree open to infection into the main stem of the tree reducing its safe useful life expectancy. No reasons have been given for the proposed works and the branch, although cankered would appear structurally sound.



The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and preserve the character of the area.
