In the sixteenth century a new building with brick foundations was constructed in the centre of the site. It was fitted with fireplace mouldings that were probably salvaged from the priory of St John. The building was subsequently modified by the addition of a cellar and was further modified over the centuries until its destruction in the nineteenth century. In the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries the medieval buildings in the east part of the site were replaced by a terrace of brick buildings with cellars, fronting onto St John Street.

Among the principal structures was a timber river wall which reinforced the north bank of the Thames. the revetment is believed to be associated with the establishment of the White Friars precinct in 1241. this structure is presumed to have continued in use until a stone river wall was constructed. Historical research suggest s that the stone wall was built in or soon after 1349. The second waterfront was itself replaced by the construction of a new stone wall approximately 40m further to the south. Landfill/levelling layers associated with the earliest (timber) wall were

excavated as they were located beyond the limits of the trenches.

Late Medieval and early Post Medieval garden soil type deposits were encountered in the two largest areas exposed. These soils probably formed as a result of an extended period of horticultural activity following the reclamation of the area from the Thames. A large timber-framed building was constructed on the east of the site in the 16th century, it probably continued in use throughout the 17th and 18th centuries. Extensive evidence of 18th century building was found to the west of this earlier structure. A complex of interconnected brick-built structures, which clearly did not for part of a dwelling, were recorded in the central area of the site. These are believed to form part of an 18th century distillery shown on Rocque's map of 1746. The distillery complex continued in use until the early 19th century.

Prehistoric stream channels were encountered, and residual worked flints dated to the Late Neolithic or Early Bronze Age. Remains of early Roman buildings were found. The Roman wall and Silchester Road bisected the site. Saxo-Norman activity was identified in the form of lined pits and an early city ditch, dated 1000-1200 with later recuttings. A bastion was added to the Roman wall c. 1230-1300. A fragment of Greyfriars Friary was recovered, from the 1306-1327 rebuild. The city ditch was backfilled in the fifteenth century and provided new living space in the post-medieval period. The Great Fire destroyed many buildings. The ruins of Wren's Christ Church Greyfriars are preserved on site. Later redevelopment included the Giltspur Street Compter prison, built in 1787 whose foundations were investigated.

Description

A watching brief to log the contents of seventeen machine excavated geotechnical pits and to monitor ground reductions across the development were carried out by the Museum of London Archaeology Service. Almost all archaeological deposits had been truncated during the twentieth century across most of the site, but there were pockets of in situ archaeology surviving beneath a site' wide dump of rubble demolition debris. the fragmentary deposits were immediately above the gravel and probably represent the remains of external dumps or truncated pit fills of medieval and post-medieval date. the only datable finds were four sherds of sixteenth century and fourteenth century pottery. the outline of a north-south medieval chalk foundation was seen on the north side of the site. A short length of a late post-medieval culverted brick drain was also seen. No finds or features dated earlier than the medieval period were encountered.
