Residual Roman pottery sherds and fragments of human remains were found on site. A large east-west drainage ditch, probably running to the Fleet, was filled with domestic refuse which could be dated between 1150 and 1350. A number of later channels or sumps truncated the backfill of the ditch, dating to the middle of the fourteenth century. To the south of the ditch was a barrel well which was backfilled at the end of the fourteenth century. A possible medieval chalk wall truncated the topmost reclamation deposits over the ditch. Another chalk and brick wall dated to the late fifteenth century but most of the other post-medieval features were truncated by modern activity. Early nineteenth century brick culvert drains survived and may have been associated with a circular brick-lined well. The drains were truncated by a series of Victorian basements and modern dumps.

Two medieval walls aligned parallel to the nearby precinct wall of the London Charterhouse were built into these. It was thought that these walls belonged to previously unknown outbuildings located outside the precinct wall. The east of the area appeared to have been open ground, and a ragstone and timber-lined feature possibly identified as a drain was recorded. This dated to the 16th century and may have been contemporary with Wash House Court which was added to accommodate the lay brothers' quarters.

Deposits and features related to the post Dissolution use of the site were also recorded. These included two brick buildings constructed against the earlier precinct wall at the west of the site, one of which was dated to the late 17th century. To the east of the site a probable 17th century gravel surface was also recorded.
