(TPO Ref: H2) REAR GARDEN: 1 x Hornbeam - Reduce in height by 30-35% and round off level with height adjacent Sycamore. Prune back lateral crown spread over the pool area by 1-2m.

- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

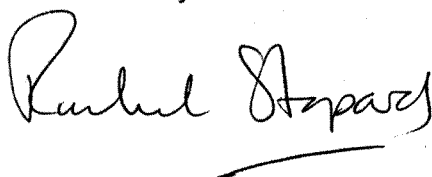
Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).
