Assessment

Proposal: the application relates to an internally illuminated fascia sign and two vinyl signs applied to the front elevation of the gym's entrance. The Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 2007 permits the Council to only consider amenity and public safety matters in determining advertisement consent applications.

Amenity: the signs do not obscure any architectural features of the building and are considered acceptable in terms of proportions and design. It is not considered that the signs would be unduly obtrusive in the street scene or disturb residents or occupiers.

Public Safety: the location of the signage is not considered harmful to either pedestrian or vehicle traffic. The proposal therefore raises no public safety concerns.

Recommendation: the proposed adverts are in general compliance with policies CS14 and DP24 of the Local Development Framework the application is therefore recommended for approval.
