Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 2 x Poplar - Fell to ground level
14 x Poplar - Reduce height of tallest by 40%. Reduce others in line with tallest trees
1 x Poplar - Trim ivy plant on trunk. Remove top 5 metres of plant
2 x Willow - Reduce crown to previous reduction points
RIGHT SIDE OF PROPERTY: 1 x Acacia - Reduce all new growth back to 30-45
centimetres above old reduction points
LEFT SIDE OF PROPERTY: 1 x Acacia - Crown reduce height and spread by 33%

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 19
September 2012 and does not wish to object.


- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is
