One tree is healthy and growing, the other identified by the previous ree surgeon working with the trees as diseased so I assume its growth has been stunted. I do not live at the property but have been told by neighbours in the adjourning properties that (presumably) the healthy tree is over grown and overhanging their properties. They fear that it will cause damage to their properties if it is not cut back.
