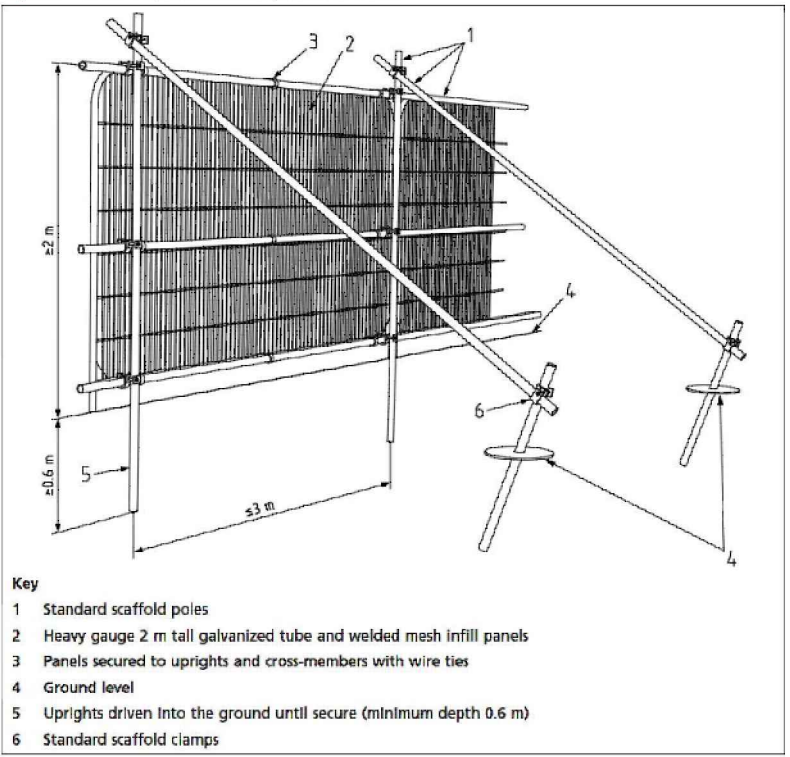
Berberis (shrub)

Care shall be taken when planning site operations to ensure that wide or tall loads or plant with booms, jibs and counterweights, can operate without coming into contact with the retained trees. Such contact could result in serious damage to them and might make their safe retention impossible. Consequently, any transit or traverse of plant in close proximity to trees T5 should be carried out under the supervision of a banksman to ensure adequate clearance from tree is maintained at all times.
