This tree needs pruning (has not been done for 6 years) Sycamore tree to rear of property close to boundary with 8/10 Ferncroft ave. This tree has grown considerably and 30% reduction in size is requested. Cherry tree at rear of property adjacent to boundary with 24 Hollycroft ave. Two dead and potentially dangerous branches which need to be removed.
