I am presently experiencing a problem with over grown trees from three neighbouring rear gardens. Because of the height and width of the trees I am only receiving a limited amount of daylight in the kitchen and bathroom.

My garden lawn and flowers have also been badly damaged since half the garden is in the shade all the time. The trees have hindered the growth of my lawn and flowers, because of the lack of natural daylight coming through.

The trees affecting my property are the Eucalyptus tree from 47 Willes Road, Kentish Town - which was last cut in June 2007, - a Lime tree from 60 Grafton Road, Kentish Town and a Bamboo tree from 62 Grafton Road, Kentish Town.

Consequently, I am making a request to have the Crown of these trees reduced, therefore enabling me to receive better lighting during the day.

I would appreciate an appointment with a Tree Admin Officer to assess this problem.
