# **Site Description**

The application site comprises a vacant plot between the end of a row of four storey 1960's terrace houses to the east and an electricity sub-station to the west. The northern boundary is formed by a brick and masonry retaining wall and a drop to the railway line below, whilst the southern boundary is formed by King Henry's Road. The site is not located within a Conservation Area.

#### **Assessment**

The application seeks to discharge details pursuant to condition 2 (brick sample) of of planning permission dated 28/10/11 (Ref: 2011/3800/P) for the erection of 3-storey building with lower ground floor level for use as a dwellinghouse (Class C3).

The proposed brick sample would be Brick Sample: Wienerberger Brick (50mmx200mm). "Melton Grey" Colour, stretcher bond with light Grey Mortar.

The sample has been inspected on site. The brick, including the colour of the mortar subtly respond to the varying colour and tone of facing materials found in the immediate vicinity. The selected brick would preserve the character and appearance of the area and will be of a suitable quality to ensure the highest standard of design and longevity.

On this basis I recommend the condition be discharged.
