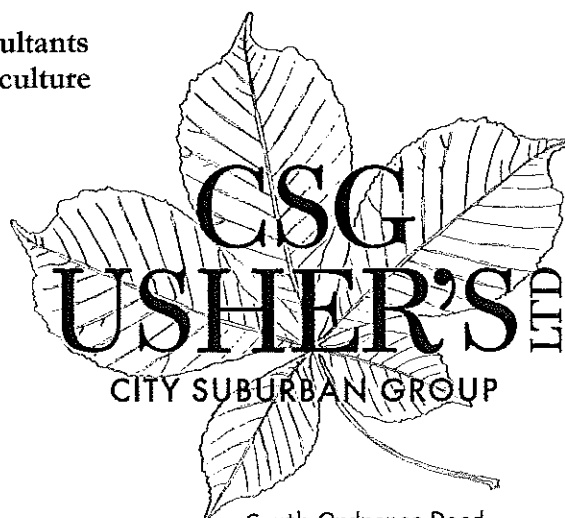

DESCRIPTION

REAR GARDEN with side access:
GROUP OF OVERGROWN TREES - Overhanging tennis court to rear:
SEMI-MATURE OAK - Reduce overall by 2-3 metres, lift and cut back over tennis court, prune to shape and tidy up.
2 x ASH - Reduce overall by 2-3 metres, lift and cut back over tennis court, prune to shape and tidy up.
ELM - Reduce overall by 2-3 metres, lift and cut back over tennis court, prune to shape and tidy up.
LARGE ELDERBERRY - Lift and cut back over tennis court only.
GENERAL VEGETATION - Lift and cut back over tennis court, lift and cut back over the garden of No. 32 Crediton Hill taking care to preserve the existing screen from the tennis court.

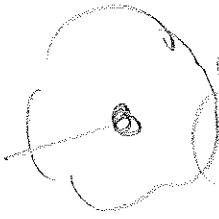

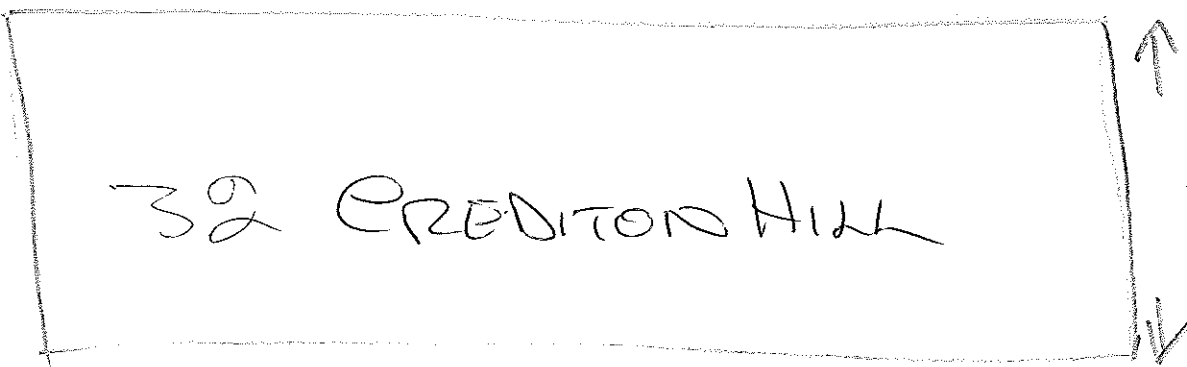
