The annex No. 1C is an empty space open to the rear behind a much altered brick facade, with a contemporary light industrial roof. The West wall of the villa appears to have been reinforced to receive such roofing, and the front elevation of No 1 C suffered the addition of 6 brick courses at the top probably to increase the height of the new roof.
