

NOTES:

REFUSE / RECYCLABLE COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS

Bin storage areas show 1 to 7 storage units each 650 x 650mm.



OFFICE AND WORKSHOP UNITS

The operators of the office and workshop units will make private arrangements for their waste and recycling collections which will take place on-street in accordance with on-street parking and loading restrictions. Bin storage locations 4 to 7 are available for temporary waste and recycling storage



RETAIL UNIT

The operators of the retail unit will make private arrangements for their waste and recycling collections which will take place on-street in accordance with on-street parking and loading restrictions.

There are therefore no designated external storage areas for commercial waste

Bin storage location 3 is available for temporary waste and recycling storage



RESIDENTIAL UNITS

There are three residential units above the retail unit, (2@ 50m2, 1@ 119m2).

Each unit has space designated internally within the kitchen accommodation for 2no. 30 litre bins, one for general waste and one for recyclables, plus 1no. 7 litre kitchen caddy for organic kitchen waste.

In accordance with Camden Planning Guidance 2011 section 10.9, Residential Developments with 6 dwellings or fewer above shops, service will be by kerbside waste and recyclables collection. For the return of recycling/waste bags, bin storage location 1 will, in addition to racking of organic waste (see below) be equipped with three receptacles for the return of recycling/waste bags.

Bin storage location 1 is available for the racking of 3 x 27litre organic kitchen waste receptacles and bin storage location 2 for waste and recycling storage.
