The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed loss of Class A1 retail floor space and replacement with an enlarged Class A3 restaurant, would result in an over-concentration of food, drink and entertainment uses and would be harmful to the special retail character, function, vitality and viability of the Covent Garden Area and the residential amenities of



neighbouring occupiers, contrary to policies CS5 (Managing the impact of growth and development) and CS7 (Promoting Camden's centres and shops) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policies DP10 (Helping and promoting small and independent shops), DP12 (Supporting strong centres and managing the impact of food, drink, entertainment and other town centre uses) and DP26 (Managing the impact of development on occupiers and neighbours) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
