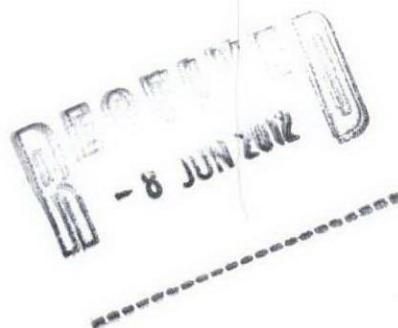

Please find enclosed on behalf of our client, British Telecommunications plc, an application for advertisement consent to display temporary advertisements on the aforementioned property that lies on the Olympic marathon route.

The application comprises the following:

The temporary advertisements have already received LOCOG (*The London Organising Committee of the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games Ltd*) approval as can be seen in the letter submitted as part of this application which also confirms BT as the official communications services partner of the Games. Furthermore, the advertisements have also been approved by the GLA who have confirmed that they do not have any concerns with the proposed designs.

The temporary advertisements will be displayed for a limited period on buildings currently occupied by British Telecommunications Ltd. The timeframe will cover both the Olympic and Paralympic Games and the advertisements will be removed in the week after the closing ceremony of the Paralympic games as stated in the enclosed application forms.
