Reasons for objection:


- 1 The Lime tree is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity within the streetscape and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area. The application suggests that the tree is implicated in subsidence. Insufficient has been submitted with the application to demonstrate that this is the case.
Evidence should include the identification of roots below foundations, soil analysis demonstrating soil desiccation and crack/level monitoring over a sufficient period to demonstrate progressive movement linked to the moisture usage of the tree in question.



A Tree Preservation Order has been served to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and to preserve the character of this part of the conservation area.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.
