1 The proposed development by reason of its bulk, mass, detailed design and proposed use of materials would result in an incongruous and excessively large



outbuilding in the locality which would harm the setting of the grade II* listed building and wider terrace, and the character and appearance of the Dartmouth Park Conservation Area contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden's Local Development Framework Development Policies.
