- Shade tolerant ground cover planting suitable for shallow soil depths
- Shade tolerant textural planting
- Low growing clump forming plant. Used to define edge of planting bed and to allow as much light as possible to the lower ground floor.
- New clear stemmed ornamental trees
- New multi stemmed tree
