The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed resurfacing of the accessway, by reason of the introduction of uncharacteristic surface material and finishes, would be harmful to the high quality and traditional setting for the surrounding buildings, and would fail to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of the Regent's Park Conservation Area contrary to Core Strategy policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and



conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design), DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

2 The proposed resurfacing of the accessway, by reason of the introduction of impervious surface materials, may increase the volume and rate of run-off of water into the combined storm water and sewer system and may have a significant adverse impact on the drainage and local water environment. This would be contrary to policies CS13 (Tackling climate change through promoting higher environmental standards) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP23 (Water) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
