The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The metal gates and railings, by reason of their design, height, width and location, create an unduly visually prominent and discordant feature, which harms the character and appearance of the host building, streetscene and this part of the Parkhill & Upper Park Conservation Area, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of



Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

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
