
- 1 The Council has approved a works to reduce these trees to the previous reduction points on the 27th April 2012 ref: 2012/2206/T, these works have not yet been implemented and are considered to be more appropriate that the works applied for here. The works proposed in this application are not in line with the previous management of these trees and are therefore not considered to be good arboricultural practice or in line with BS5837:2010 Tree work: recommendations.



This application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and to preserve the character of this part of the conservation area.
