A selection of artists that we have so far for the project include:



**DUGGIE FIELDS:** A British artist whose work has progressed from minimal, conceptual and constructivist phases to a more hard-edge-post-Pop figuration. He has worked in various media including film, video and television.



**DAVID MACH** Scottish Sculpture and installation artist. David created Out of Order, 1989 in Kingston Upon Thames: an installation of twelve telephone boxes, first one upright, the rest gradually falling over like dominoes.



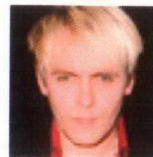
**LILY COLE:** Model, Film Actress and Entrepreneur. Lily has had a passion for art all her life and has received a double-First in History of Art from Cambridge University.
