The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission subject to the following condition(s):

Condition(s) and Reason(s):

- 1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.



Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

- 2 The colour of the proposed satellite dishes, aerial and equipment cabinet shall be painted dark grey or black. The supporting mount shall be designed to be as unobtrusive as possible, and should be painted the same colour as the satellite dishes. The associated cabling and fixings shall match as closely as possible the building fabric upon which they are positioned.

Reason: In order to minimize the impact on the appearance of the building and local environment in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

- 3 The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans: Site Location Plan; Drawing no(s) E12053/01 Rev P1; E45214/00; E45214/02 to E12053/09; Design and Access Statement (IRS Programme)

For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

- 1 Reasons for granting permission. [Delegated]

The proposed development is in general accordance with the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, with particular regard to policies (CS5 - Managing the impact of growth and development), CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) and the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies, with particular regard to policies DP24 (Securing high quality design), DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage), DP26 (Managing the impact of development on occupiers and neighbours). For a more detailed understanding of the reasons for the granting of this planning permission, please refer to the officers report.

- 2 Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. You must carry out any building works that can be heard at the boundary of the site only between 08.00 and 18.00 hours Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 13.00 on Saturday and not at all on Sundays and Public Holidays. You are advised to consult the Council's Compliance and Enforcement team [Regulatory Services], Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ (Tel. construction other than within the hours stated above.

- 3 You are advised that any existing TV reception equipment which is either unauthorised, or has been installed under Permitted Development rights but becomes superseded by the equipment hereby approved, must be removed from the building.
