My enquiry is: Hi I am concerned about a tree in our garden. It is a poplar tree. My gardener tells me it is dangerous as it is very high. Compared to the trunk the crown is extremely overgrown. we noticed some insects inside the tree and one day a lot of the trees insides had been burrowed out (possibly by a beaver/squirrel). The tree is entirely hollow on the inside. Do we need permission to trim/reduce it? I rang the council and they said it wasn't a protected tree, however we do come under a conservation area. PLease could you advise what we should/shouldnt do.

There is also a large tree outside our house at the front, there is one branch that completely overhangs my neighbours and part of our driveway and house. we keep getting cracks in our walls and coving, I am just concerned it could be due to this tree. Is there any chance someone from the council could come take a look and if necessary, reduce this, as it is on the street and therefore I'm guessing council responsibility to reduce. The roots of this tree are so large and deep, the entire footpath is uneven and has caused a number of accidents of residents, tripping over this uneven surface. Please could someone urgently take a look at this.
