The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The frameless glazed doors, by reason of their detailed design, materials and location on the building are detrimental to the character and appearance of the historic building and the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to Policy CS14 (Promoting high Quality Places and Conserving Our Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and Policies DP24 (Securing High Quality Design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development



Framework Development Policies.

# Informative(s):

You are advised that a further application for planning permission and listed building consent should be submitted for replacement outer timber doors to the three openings. These should be careful replicas of the original historic joinery which would allow visibility, light transfer and would be considerably more draft-proof.
