<u>Design & Access Statement</u> <u>For Proposed renewal and repair of windows to</u> <u>No. 1 Doughty Street</u> <u>and No. 1 Roger Street WC1</u>

No 1 Roger Street and No. 1 Doughty Street are attached and are Listed buildings, with Doughty Street being a street of great Historical past, and to some degree very prestigous present day occupants.

Unfortunately the windows of both buildings have not been looked after with the loving care and attention that they obviously need, and have therefore deteriorated into a very poor state of repair

This proposal is to repair where possible those windows where repair is an option or otherwise to replace them in an identical form such that they will not detract from the buildings appearance as they are now.

The windows on Roger Street are a mixture of metal and timber, the metal being old Crittal windows which are no longer available in the UK, they are in a very bad state of repair and need replacing throughout before they collapse into the street, and it is proposed to do this in hardwood but retaining both the shape and the size of the existing windows such that for all intents and purposes they will look exactly the same as the existing windows which are painted black in colour.
