

(Left) Context. Many many of the other buildings on Gower Court have flues, vents and plant machinery, and fire escape stairs mounted on their facades. therefore, we believe the proposals make little difference to the character of the space.

(Below) visual impact of proposed rooftop plant represented in blue. Proposed plant to be mounted on existing deck, and so impact is minimal.





(Above) visual impact of proposed flues and ducts represented in blue. As stated above, given the abundance of visible external plant, ducts and escape stairs in the immediate context, we believe the proposals do not significantly impact the character of the space.

The proposal seeks to relocate the existing flues from the south to the north elevation.
