Generally

Protect original fabric inclusive of masonry, timber, plaster and metalwork.

Note that the building is Grade II* Listed.

Where not expressly marked in red for demolition on drawings 220_G_010C, 220_G_011D and 220_G_012C, the presumption should be that fabric, finishes and details are to be protected and retained.
