T1: Large Chestnut – Fell. Two Large Chestnuts adjacent to this tree have recently suffered complete failure in high winds, narrowly missing the building, the college wish to remove the threat of further potential damage by removing this tree which is now exposed due to the loss of the other two trees.

T2: Plum tree x 2 - Reduce the side back to give 2 metres clearance from the adjacent building.

T3: Lombardy Poplar - Fell. Tree decayed at base.


T4: Cherry - Fell. Tree decayed and leaning. Old fungal fruiting body present.

T5 and T6: False Acacia x 2 - Fell. Poor specimens, in decline.

T7: False Acacia - Reduce the large section overhanging the adjacent property by 30%, remove dead wood from the remaining crown.

All trees marked NW on plan are False Acacia's removal of dead wood only and retention of trees.
