REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime - Remove.

The Council has considered your application dated 01 November 2011 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The tree is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity within this part of the conservation area. Damage to the wall appears to be minor in nature and no structural engineer's report has been submitted to suggest otherwise. It is considered any damaged part of the wall could be rebuilt to take into account the position of the tree and any future growth potential.

The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and to preserve the character of this part of the conservation area.
