In reference to application **2011/2835/L** approved on 07/09/2011, we are seeking to discharge **condition 4a** as follows:

- i. Statement of structural alterations necessary to reposition the doorway: To reposition the doorway between reception room and kitchen, we first intend to remove the existing door and architrave and save for re-use. We will then infill the existing opening using timber stud and plasterboard to match the existing construction of the remaining, modern wall. We will then create a new opening in the position shown on the drawings using a timber frame and lintel of standard construction. We will then place the existing re-used door in the newly created opening. The wall will then be skim-coated with plaster, and the existing architrave will be re-used around the opening.
