HERITAGE STATEMENT

9a Hampstead High Street London NW3 1PR

Over time the window panes at 9a Hampstead High Street have loosened in their frames. The sealant (putty) is aged and crumbling. The windows rattle in high winds and when the rain is at a certain angle the wooden frames can no longer fully protect the woodwork and surrounding brickwork from damp. Strange as it may seem, noise nuisance is not really the issue here. This application is driven from a preservation point of view. The aim is to protect and preserve a Grade II listed property by maintaining adequate insulation – while at the same time showing absolutely no visible change to the original appearance of the building.
