#### **Reason(s) for Refusal**

- 1 The development results in an unacceptable loss of a Class A1 retail shop unit to the harm of the character and function and vitality and viability of the Camden Town Centre. The development thereby conflicts with Policy CS7 (promoting Camden's Centres) of the London Borough of Camden Core Strategy 2010 and Policies DP12 (Supporting strong centres and managing the impact of non retail town centre uses) and DP10 (helping and promoting small and independent shops) of the London Borough of Camden Development Plan Policies 2010.
