Bloomsbury Conservation Area Statement

Assessment

Proposal:

Permission is sought to replace the existing sign and canopy layout at the main entrance to the casino with a simplified canopy.

Assessment:

The existing entrance arrangement consists of a curved canopy above a large internally illuminated fascia sign, adjacent to this is a long projecting canopy. The proposal would see the curved entrance canopy replaced with a simplified canopy structure which matches the adjoining.

The proposal is considered to be acceptable, the existing arrangement appears messy and unattractive, removing the existing curved canopy and fascia sign and continuing the adjoining canopy above the main entrance is considered to be an improvement in terms of design.

The proposal would not impact upon the amenity of adjoining occupiers as it is within a hotel forecourt, nor will it impact upon pedestrians or vehicles as it is would be more than 2m above ground level.

It is noted that internally illuminated lettering is included on the drawings; this is currently subject to a separate and concurrent application (reference 2011/6018/A).

Recommendation: Grant Planning Permission.

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
