Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime - Remove all new growth.

1 x Acacia - Clean through crown removing deadwood.

1 x Pear - Lightly reduce and prune to shape.

1 x Mixed Hedge - Reduce to 2.5m and trim one side.

1 x Sycamore - Remove deadwood only.

1 x Ash - Cut back crown to previous reduction points. Reduce large decayed limb over the garden by 50%.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 29 November 2011 and does not wish to object.


