Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime - Remove all new growth.

- 1 x Acacia Clean through crown removing deadwood.
- 1 x Pear Lightly reduce and prune to shape.
- 1 x Mixed Hedge Reduce to 2.5m and trim one side.
- 1 x Sycamore Remove deadwood only.
- 1 x Ash Cut back crown to previous reduction points. Reduce large decayed limb over the garden by 50%.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 29 November 2011 and does not wish to object.

- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
