NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED TREE WORK IN THE PRIMROSE HILL CONSERVATION AREA

I am writing on behalf of Mr Jeffrey Twentyman, of 183 Gloucester Avenue, London NW1 8LA, to notify you of proposed work to a bay laurel/sweet bay (*Laurus nobilis*) in his front garden. A sketch map of the position of the tree is given overleaf and supplementary information is provided in the attached report (AR 7133.pdf).

The proposed work is to fell the tree and grind out the roots to about 300mm below ground level.

The work is to prevent continuing damage to basement flank walls and the storm porch, and is on the recommendation of a chartered surveyor's report of July 2011.


Mr Twentyman intends to replace the tree with a birch or hornbeam to be planted in the front garden but further away from his home than the position of the bay laurel.
