Dear Alex,

I wish to carry out tree work on 5 sites, all of which are in camden conservation areas. All trees are owned by One Housing Group - (contact Joanne 07986802918):

- 1.. 42 St. Pauls Crescent, NW1. For access call Howard Shooter @ No. 44 - 07973 761 790. I intend to fell the Ash tree pushing the boundary wall, as it is causing damage.
- 2.. 35 - 36 Belsize Square, NW3. For access call Joanne (above). I wish to reduce the holly, crab apple & lime tree in the rear garden by 25% because the garden has become overgrown and dominated by these trees.
- 3.. Flat 4, 19 Mornington Crescent, NW1 7RG. Contact Frank for access - 0207 387 5493. We wish to reduce the Tree of Heaven and Cherry tree by 30%, as these are overshadowing the area and growing close to the building.
4. 26a Hillfield Road, NW6 1PZ. The tree here - a lime tree - is at the end of the rear garden, and can be viewed from the high street. This mature tree is leaning towards an area of high traffic. It is on a raised bed, and requires regular pruning to keep the wait and wind-sail in the upper crown low. I wish to reduce the crown by 25%.
5. Flat A, 31 Bartolamews Road, NW5 2AH. Contact Lynne - 0207 482 5514 - to view. Two lime trees in the front garden are blocking all light and touching the building. I plan to reduce the crowns by 25%. The single lime in the rear garden will be reduced by 20% to allow more light into the garden areas.
